THANKSGIVING CONVERSATION GUIDE

Holiday gatherings with family and friends are a perfect opportunity to build support for Paid Family Leave in New York. Here are some quick tips for having conversations about the issue and using the resources in this packet.

- Think ahead about the best time to have conversations. Should you talk to people one-onone or speak to everyone at once? If you're not hosting the gathering, consider letting the host know that you'll be talking about this issue. If you're engaging everyone in a group conversation, pick a time when most people will be assembled. A good choice is during or right after dessert.
- 2

Start with a personal story, like the birth of a baby or a family member who had a serious accident or illness. Telling others about how this issue has affected you will help them understand why it's so important. Then, encourage others to share their experiences.

3 Mention the national conversation about Paid Family Leave. Note that the United State is one of only two countries in the world that doesn't have Paid Family Leave. Explain that while there's a push in Congress, New York State has a very active campaign that can win Paid Family Leave next year.

If you get questions or concerns about the details, share the fact sheet included in this packet. There's also tons of info online at timetocareny.org.

- 5 Once you've gotten some support, it's time to take action! Take a photo of yourself and your family or friends with the sign in this packet. Share the photo on your Facebook page or on Twitter with the hashtag #PaidLeave. Make sure to tag the others in the photo and ask them to share it too!

If someone you've talked with has a story about how lack of Paid Family Leave impacted them, make sure to get their story. We've included a form in this packet that you can use to collect the story.

NEW YORK NEEDS PAID FAMILY LEAVE

YOU SHOULDN'T HAVE TO CHOOSE







New Yorkers shouldn't have to choose between their paycheck and caring for their loved ones. The Paid Family Leave Insurance Act would provide up to 12 weeks of paid leave to bond with a new child, care for a seriously ill family member, and deal with issues that arise when a family member is called to active military service.

The legislation would create a paid family leave insurance benefit and modernize New York's Temporary Disability Insurance (TDI) program, the critical support system for new mothers physically recovering from childbirth, which is currently frozen at the 1989 rate of \$170 per week.

With paid family leave, employees would be able to care for their loved ones without losing a paycheck or having to use sick or vacation time.

Only 13% of private sector workers have paid family leave. All of New York's 7.5 million private sector workers should have access.



Workers would receive up to 12 weeks of paid family leave benefits, which would be capped at \$633/week.



Paid family leave is great for small business because it lowers employee turnover and boosts morale.



High-wage workers are more than five times as likely to have paid family leave than low-wage workers.

- → "My 10 year old son can't take himself for dialysis..."
- \rightarrow "My wife needs someone to be with her during chemotherapy..."
- \rightarrow "My father was dying from leukemia; I wanted to be there with him for those final weeks ..."
